- Tempered Glazing (Lee)
 - Fire Sprinkler requirements – how to inspect these systems (Sean)
 - Decks, gazebos, and other detached structures (Russell)

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- Corrosion resistant fasteners (Russell will bring his research presented to the chapter last year and we can compare to 2013 CRC and CBC requirements)
- Cutting and notching of framing members (compare recommendations by CRC, CBC, UPC of sawn lumber and Engineered Wood Products) (Kurt?, Karyn will bring EWP recs)
- Fire resistive construction (CRC and WUI) (David?)
- Coordination of CALGreen and CRC (Will direct to CALGreen Committee for their ideas)
